

# Bye-laws and rules

## Notice of General Meeting by electronic means

A general meeting of the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries (IFoA) was held electronically on Thursday 27 October at 12:00 BST, further to an electronic vote held between Tuesday 27 September and Tuesday 25 October 2022. The following Motion was put to the meeting:

### Approval of a revised disciplinary scheme

**To pass a Resolution to replace the current Disciplinary and Capacity for Membership Schemes with the revised Disciplinary Scheme (at Appendix 1) as Rule 20 of the IFoA's Rules.**

A Motion to replace the current Disciplinary and Capacity for Membership Schemes with a revised Disciplinary Scheme was passed by a simple majority of members entitled to vote and voting at the general meeting (in accordance with Article 14a of the Charter).

As confirmed in the Notice of this General Meeting, the revised Disciplinary Scheme will (having now been formally approved by our members) take effect in early 2023. The exact date of its introduction is to be confirmed; at this time the revised Scheme will be formally published on the IFoA's website (in accordance with our Bye-law 30) and notice will be given to members.
