

PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS DIRECTORY - Update 28

It is designed to permit members and others to access the current Financial Reporting Council (FRC) Standards together with the current versions of the Actuarial Profession Standards (APSs). In addition Information and Assistance Notes (IANs) are provided for all our members, including those who may not have any specialised knowledge in the relevant area. It is not mandatory for members to have regard to an IAN.

IAN: The Actuary as an Expert Witness – Version 2.0 has been issued with effect from 15 February 2013 (which can be found [here](#))

This IAN is intended to assist actuaries in the United Kingdom whenever they are instructed as an expert in proceedings before civil courts or tribunals. It is also intended to be helpful to actuaries preparing reports in other jurisdictions and when they have been instructed in an advisory expert, rather than expert witness capacity.

An APS is currently being developed to replace the IAN and is expected to be out for consultation at the end of March.
